MISSION

Diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation Highly personalized health services

The Villa Berica Nursing Home is based in Vicenza and is accredited with the National Health System. Villa Berica is an efficient specialist center where health services are provided for the diagnosis and treatment of numerous pathologies, both in ordinary hospitalization and on an outpatient basis. It is a modern structure, with a strong focus on hotel comfort and technological innovation, which aims to provide effective and personalized care, thus making the patient's hospital stay shorter and more comfortable.

The clinic offers health services in the medical-surgical and orthopedic areas, making use of a qualified analysis laboratory and a diagnostic center with state-of-the-art equipment. Villa Berica is a center of reference for diabetology, with particular attention to the prevention and treatment of the complications of diabetes affecting the lower limbs (Diabetic Foot), for which excellent levels of quality of care have been achieved.

The Nursing Home is committed to responding to the ever-increasing demands of users, ensuring continuity of care after hospital discharge to patients with chronic diseases.

Villa Berica is an important point of reference for outpatient activities in the area. You can book visits and consultations with specialist doctors operating in the field of cardiology, general surgery, dermatology, diabetology / endocrinology, physiatry, gastroenterology, gynecology, laboratory medicine, internal medicine, nephrology, neurology, ophthalmology, orthopedics, otolaryngology, pneumology, diagnostic radiology, pain therapy anesthesia, allergology and urology.





HISTORY

The Villa Berica Nursing Home was born in Vicenza in the early 1930s with a surgical address. In the early 1950s, the ophthalmologist Prof. Alessandro Trettenero takes over the property together with his family. During its management, the clinic undergoes a major transformation, integrating services agreed with the National Health Service into the private relationship with users. Over the years the hospitalization activity has diversified and qualified, offering the patient a wide range of inpatient and outpatient services. The growth in the supply of health services has always been accompanied by continuous restructuring, expansion and technological adaptation. In 2000, the surgeon Prof. Raffaele Garofalo, president of one of the most important Italian private healthcare groups, decided to buy the Nursing Home directly from the Trettenero family, thus accelerating the transition from classical surgery to the most current and modern surgical techniques such as laparoscopy. and interventional endoscopy, thus favoring the patient's functional recovery in a very short time.

In 2003 the new operating group was inaugurated consisting of 4 surgical rooms equipped with the best equipment and technologies, to which a hemodynamics room and a surgical clinic have recently been added. Since 2016, the Nursing Home has been equipped with two Intensive Care beds. Villa Berica is UNI EN ISO 9001/2015 certified.

The facility has 108 authorized beds, divided into single, double and triple rooms, where it welcomes patients both in ordinary hospitalization and in Day Surgery. All rooms are equipped with independent toilets with shower, television and motorized bed and air conditioning and free wi-fi. In the case of private hospitalizations or those paying the hotel difference, the hospitalization room can be totally reserved for the patient with the possibility of using the free bed by a family member or acquaintance. The rooms are arranged on three floors connected to each other by lifts and litter lifts. The paths are free of architectural barriers. The main entrance is accessed by a large covered staircase served by a lift. The driveway entrance at number n. 8 is used by ambulances and service vehicles.

SERVICES



The nursing home provides the following services:

• a gym for physiotherapy and rehabilitation activities; • a chapel for Catholic rite religious services; • food service: distributors are located

throughout the Nursing Home

automatic hot and cold drinks and snacks.

Religious Assistance The

Catholic chapel, on the second floor of the Nursing Home, is always open; Holy Mass is celebrated on Sundays and public holidays at 9.15 am. Upon request, Holy Communion is taken to the ward. Spiritual assistance is guaranteed daily by a Religious who collects requests and distributes Holy Communion at the request of the patients. A Priest guarantees the celebration of Holy Mass and other religious rites and is available to patients and their families on the occasion of the liturgical celebration or on call (notify the Sister or the Coordinator Nurse or the Ward Nurse).

Villa Berica offers its services in compliance with the values and beliefs of the patients, therefore it is available to contact, if requested, a minister of worship to which the patient belongs.

Hairdresser and barber The patient

who wishes to use this service can contact his / her trusted hairdresser. The department staff will make available the appropriate room for the hairdresser to perform the service. If necessary, the patient can contact the Coordinating Nurse.

Transfusion service

If a transfusion of blood or blood products is necessary, the Nursing Home has an agreement with the Immunotransfusion Service of the Vicenza Hospital. For any request or information, contact the attending physician.

Health transport service In the event that an

ambulance transport is necessary, to and from the Nursing Home, you can contact the medical aid and transport associations directly (Italian Red Cross - tel 0444 514222, Green Cross - tel. 0444 911900, other associations) or by requesting information from the Nurse Coordinator of the hospitalization ward.

Outpatient Services The

services are provided as a freelance professional or in agreement with the National Health System. Reservations must be made directly at the counter (from Monday to Friday from 7.30 to 20.00; on Saturday from 7.30 to 13.00) or by telephone at 0444 219200 (from Monday to Friday from 8.00 to 18.00, on Saturday from 8.00 to 12.00); it is necessary to have with you the referral from the attending physician, the magnetic health card and the tax code. For more specific information, refer to the pages of the individual Outpatient Services.

Analysis Laboratory The

sample collection and delivery service is active from Monday to Friday from 7.10 to 10.10, on Saturdays from 7.30 to 9.30 for examinations under the convention or private regime (they do not require a medical prescription). To take advantage of the services, it is sufficient to present yourself at the front-office with an identity document and tax code and, for examinations under the agreed regime, also the referral from the attending physician, health card and any exemption certificate.

There is also the possibility to fix the **withdrawal by appointment** (day and time) by calling 0444 219200/219122 (from 8.00 to 16.00)

COLLECTION OF REPORTS

Outpatient Services The

reports can be collected at the front office from Monday to Friday (from 7.30 to 20.00; on Saturdays from 7.30 to 13.00). For most of the services, the report is issued directly by the specialist doctor at the end of the visit, or sent by courier (see the pages of the individual Outpatient Services for more details).

The reports of visits and examinations must be delivered exclusively to the User to whom they refer. The latter can delegate a third person by filling in a form attached to a copy of the identity document of the delegating party and of the delegated person. In the case of minors or disabled persons, the report will be delivered exclusively to those exercising parental authority or guardians.

Analysis Laboratory The

report of the exams can be collected at the front office on the date indicated by the sampling staff (from Monday to Friday from 8.00 to 20.00 and on Saturday from 8.00 to 13.30).

The reports of visits and examinations must be delivered exclusively to the User to whom they refer. The latter can delegate a third person by filling in a form attached to a copy of the identity document of the delegating party and of the delegated person. In the case of minors or disabled persons, the report will be delivered exclusively to those exercising parental authority or guardians. Furthermore, it may be required to send the laboratory test report by courier or email.

The cytological or histological examination report can be collected personally by the patient (or by a delegated person) or sent by email.



SURGICAL DEPARTMENT

The Surgical Department groups the following surgical specialties:

Based on the severity of the pathology, the complexity of the intervention and the regulations in force, surgical interventions can be performed in ordinary hospitalization, day surgery or outpatient. The hospitalization can be private or affiliated with the National Health Service (SSN).

GENERAL SURGERY

Main pathologies treated: •

Abdominal surgery (gallbladder, colon and stomach diseases, hernias) • Oncological surgery • Proctological surgery (hemorrhoids, fissures, anal fistulas) • Venous vascular surgery of the limbs • Breast surgery • Neck surgery (thyroid and parathyroid glands)

• Thermoablation and alcoholization (small tumors of the liver, kidney and thyroid)

DAY SURGERY

Surgical pathologies that can be cured with a stay limited to daytime hours are treated in Day Surgery or Outpatient Surgery.

If the Doctor deems it inadvisable to discharge on the day of the surgery, the patient will be kept in the Nursing Home for as long as necessary.

ANALGESIC THERAPY

The Pain Therapy Center is part of the "Villa Berica Painless Nursing Home" project. It is aimed at patients suffering from acute and chronic pain caused by different pathologies of the nervous, vascular, musculoskeletal and visceral systems as well as neoplastic pathologies.

support of Vascular Medicine, a digitalized angiography service is active for the hemodynamic study and angioplasty involving the arteries of the lower limbs.

Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine

We mainly welcome patients suffering from: • Orthopedic

pathology (hip and knee prostheses - polytrauma - other orthopedic pathologies complicated by polymorbidity) • Neurological pathology (stroke - exacerbations or new accidents in the course of developmental pathologies) • Rheumatological pathology • Amputations • Hypokinetic syndromes resulting from acute events The patient is monitored daily in his clinical stabilization by an Internist.

The rehabilitation intervention is intended for at least 3 hours a day, from Monday to Friday. On Saturdays the treatment is carried out in reduced hours and concentrated in the morning hours. The rehabilitation program is carried out by the rehabilitation team made up of Physiatrist, Physiotherapists, Nursing Staff, Assistance Operators. The patient himself and the caregivers (family members or reference persons, involved in the overall care of the patient) are fully part of the team for sharing the Individual Rehabilitation Project (PRI).

Long -term care

For patients who have passed the acute phase of the disease, but who need a further period of hospitalization for treatment and rehabilitation therapies, or who are waiting to organize a home assistance service or reception at other social and health facilities (RSA, Nursing Home, Hospice), the Nursing Home provides a long-term care ward.

Diabetes Day Hospital The Villa

Berica Nursing Home has a Diabetes Unit specializing in the prevention and treatment of diabetic disease and its acute and chronic complications in a day hospital setting.

In Italy there are over 4 million people with diabetes, 250,000 in the Veneto alone. The Vicenza facility has therefore decided to specialize in the treatment of what is now called the "complex meta-bolus syndrome", paying particular attention to the problem of the diabetic foot.

Day hospital - Center for minimally invasive hepatology and oncological therapies Thermoablation treatment for the removal of selected liver, kidney and thyroid tumors. Alcoholization for the treatment of solid nodules or liquid thyroid cysts.



ADMISSION METHOD

DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE

General medicine: with a

(binding) proposal from the General Practitioner, subject to evaluation of the case by the Ward Doctor; on the proposal of the Medical Specialists of the Nursing Home, after an outpatient visit, to the patient's GP who will be able to produce a hospitalization request with which to access the booking.

Rehabilitation: with

a proposal to transfer from a hospital ward for the continuation of rehabilitation treatment in hospitalization. For transfer methods, refer to the Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine Service (tel. 0444 219119 from 8.30 to 17.00 from Monday to Friday and Saturday morning).

Long-term care: with

a proposal to transfer from a hospital ward for continuation of treatment and / or planning of a protected discharge. For transfer procedures, refer to the Coordinating Nurse of the Department (tel. 0444 219160 from 8.00 to 16.30 from Monday to Friday).



ADMISSION METHOD

SURGICAL DEPARTMENT

Access to surgical services takes place on the proposal of the Medical Specialists of the Nursing Home, after an outpatient visit. The patient who chooses to have an operation in the Nursing Home will ask his GP to produce a referral for hospitalization with which he can access the booking of the anesthetic visit and the subsequent intervention. The booking of the hospitalization must be made by telephone to the Intervention Planning Office (tel. 0444 219146) from 11.00 to 15.00 from Monday to Friday or by email at ricoveri@villaberica.com with the following documentation:

A. In agreement with the SSN:

1. intervention planning sheet with the Preoperative File obtained at the time of the intervention proposal); identification document and tax code

B. In insurance form (for members of one of the following Bodies with which Villa Berica has an agreement - Europe Assistance, Cliniservice, Assirete, Interpartner, Unisalute, Previmedical, Mon dial Assistance, Health Systems, Company Managers: FASI, FASDAC.): 1. intervention planning sheet with the Preoperative File obtained at the time of the intervention proposal; 2. document certifying the right to assistance by one of the aforementioned bodies; 3. identification document; 4. Tax Code.

C. In a private regime (with services paid for by the patient): 1. intervention planning

sheet (issued by the Specialist Doctor with the Pre-operative File at the time of the intervention proposal); Subsequently, he must produce the following additional documentation to the Secretariat and Wards Office: documents 3) and 4) referred to in point B.

The rates of the Nursing Home are available at the Secretariat and Hospitalization Office. The User has the right to choose the Doctor to rely on and to be hosted in an exclusive room with additional hotel comforts.

Admission for hospitalization

Admission usually takes place in the morning from 6.30 to 9.00 or in the afternoon from 14.30 to 15.30.

Precise times and methods will in any case be communicated directly at the time of scheduling the admission. The hospitalization certificate and its communication to INPS must be requested by the patient upon entering the ward.

What to bring

It is advisable to bring reports of diagnostic tests in possession, discharge letters (or copies of medical records) of any previous hospitalizations, information on drugs used, allergies, treatments performed previously or in progress, linen, slippers and the necessary for personal care and hygiene. It is strongly advised not to bring valuables and large sums of money.

Rest

In order to favor the afternoon and night rest, please observe silence, speak in a low voice, turn down the cell phone ringtone as much as possible and avoid any other noise, as much as possible. The use of the TV in the room is freely allowed as long as it does not cause disturbance or splendor to the patients in the same room. It is a good rule not to keep the TV on late in the evening,

at night or in any other situation in which it may disturb or disturb the peace and civil coexistence between the patients. When you leave your room it is good practice to inform the ward nurse. After 9.00 pm it is not allowed to leave your room.

Monday to Sunday: from 15.00 - 17.30 and from 19.00 - 20.30 on Sundays and holidays also from 11.00 - 11.30

SURGICAL DEPARTMENT ADMISSION SECTION: from Monday to

Sunday: from 17.00 - 21.00 on Sundays and holidays also from 10.00 - 11.00

VISITS OUTSIDE THE SCHEDULED HOURS:

In particular situations, subject to the indication / authorization of the Coordinating Nurse, one person is allowed to stay for the entire day / night.

RESTAURANT SERVICE

Differentiated and personalized menus based on preferences and dietary prescriptions are prepared every day by the qualified staff in charge of the kitchen inside the Nursing Home. It is not recommended to supplement the diet provided by the department with food and / or drinks from outside the hospital. Any special requests and / or information relating to dietary regimes can be made to the Coordinating Nurse and the Treating Doctors.

INTERVIEWS WITH DOCTORS

The Treating Doctors are available to family members who wish to have information on the clinical status of their relative (only if authorized by the same). Just make arrangements with the Coordinating Nurse or Ward Nurses to make an appointment.

CONSULT WITH EXTERNAL DOCTORS

The Patient has the right to request consultations and surgical acts from trusted Doctors, external to the Nursing Home, supporting the related charges in private. It is advisable to discuss this in advance with the ward doctor.

RESIGNATION

The date of discharge is communicated to the patient, or to a family member, a few days in advance. For organizational reasons, please vacate the room by 10.00 am.

Upon discharge, the patient will be given a clinical report showing the results of the diagnostic tests and / or of the medical-surgical intervention, the therapies and behaviors to be followed at home, the dates for subsequent checks and telephone numbers for further information or problems.

In the case of long-term hospitalizations in which a discharge to the home or a transfer to a social-health setting (RSA, Nursing Home, etc.) is envisaged, a "protected mission" plan will be activated aimed at planning and guaranteeing appropriate health or social services that can be provided at home or in a protected facility. The "protected discharge" must be planned from the beginning of the long-term hospitalization. To this end, family members will be supported and involved in a guided way by the Doctor and the Nurse Coordinator of the ward.

POST ADMISSION CHECK VISITS

They are carried out at the doctor's office on the basis of the appointment set on the letter of discharge.

MEDICAL RECORDS

It is a confidential personal document, kept by the Nursing Home. To have a copy, the person in charge of the medical record can contact the front office directly from Monday to Friday from 7.30 to 20.00 and on Saturday from 8.00 to 12.00 or send via email (frontoffice @

The photocopy is issued within forty days of the request. In urgent cases (cancer patients) delivery is expected as soon as possible.
